EAT TOGETHER | *Showing up regularly to share life and build relationships*

1. After spending some time catching up, consider reading [Psalm 146:3-10](#) to open your time of conversation and reflection. Is there anything you've had to depend on God for this week?
2. Share about a time in your life when you felt overlooked. How has that experience stuck with you?

PRAY TOGETHER | *Joining in on conversations of life and faith*

1. What stood out to you in [this week's service](#)? Was there something that made you pause and contemplate? Feel free to watch the [message recap](#) to review the big ideas of the message.
2. Read [Acts 6:1-7](#). This passage records one of the first known conflicts of the church. Based on what we learned in this week's message, what do you think was the underlying issue in the conflict? What may have been the underlying attitudes in the conflict?
3. What are some other ways injustice and inequality can creep into the church community?
4. Read Jesus' words in [Luke 4:18-19](#). This was how Jesus described his mission in the world. How do you think Jesus' mission helped guide the apostles in their response to the conflict and injustice?
5. How might Niagara be impacted if they saw the church increase its commitment to justice and equality across our region?

LOVE TOGETHER | *Being real to care and make a difference*

1. How are you growing in embedding the *message of Jesus* into your heart & mind? What are some practices that could help you do that?
2. How are you growing in expressing his *mission of justice* into the lives of others? What are some ways you could live that out?
3. What's one step you feel led to take, as a result of this week's conversation, in order to experience more of the movement of God in your life and our community?
