#### **EAT TOGETHER** | Showing up regularly to share life and build relationships

- 1. For those who've participated in the Community Bible Reading Plan, what has stood out to you in those readings?

#### **PRAY TOGETHER** | Joining in on conversations of life and faith

- 1. We encourage you to watch as a group, the message <u>recap</u> to review the big ideas of the message. This will refresh our memories and result in richer conversations.
- 2. What are often regarded as the indicators of a strong/successful church?
  - a. How is this similar or different from the condition of the church in Philadelphia?
  - b. How is this similar or different from the condition of our church, Southridge?
- 3. In a city that was named after love and to a church that was built on open-door love, Jesus provided no correction but only encouragement. What do you find most interesting or significant about that?
- 4. Have you faced any criticism or negativity for why you attend a church like Southridge? If so, how does that feel and how have you responded in the past? What might a "love beyond belief" response look like?
- 5. What is one big idea that you learned or impacted you from this message, that you can hold onto this week?

## **LOVE TOGETHER** | Being real to care and make a difference

- 1. How can you keep living out Jesus' open-door love together at Southridge, even if/when we face challenges related to our resources or reputation?
- 2. If/when you experience criticism from other Christians for your belonging to a church like ours, who in the Southridge community, or your life group, could you seek out for encouragement/advice?
