Students may want to bring additional snacks. Extra money may be nice to purchase treats or merchandise, but it is not necessary. Note that this is a camping weekend, so if you have a tent, please let us know!

Drop off and pick up information will be confirmed closer to the event, but will likely be leaving our Vineland location on Friday, May 17 at 5:00pm and returning to our Vineland location on Monday, May 20 at 3:00pm. To keep the cost down – we are trying to meet Early Bird registration! As a result – the deadline is Monday, April 15.
